1. Introduction

The European Volleyball Confederation is pleased to open the registration procedure for the CEV U17 Women / U18 Men Volleyball European Championship 2022, the 1st Round of qualifiers for this competition will be played in the Zonal level and the 2nd Round will be played under the supervision of the CEV.

The organisers and dates for the Final Round are as follows:

- U18 Men – in Tbilisi (GEO) (dates 9-17/07/2022 TBC)
- U17 Women – in Olomouc and Prostějov (CZE) (dates 22-31/07/2022 TBC)

Apart from the host countries, all other National Federations (NFs) will compete in qualifying rounds scheduled for 2021/2022 to book their places in the Final Round, which will be played with 12 teams per gender.

The competition format for the 2022 edition remains the same as for the 2020 edition of the age category U17 Women / U18 Men.

This Championship will be managed and processed via the CEV database and therefore we ask all NFs to apply the necessary accuracy while working with it.

It remains the sole responsibility of the NFs to respect all Communications, Regulations, Guidelines and institutional decisions to guarantee the delivery of correct, accurate and complete data at any time that these are required.

2. Age Limit

According to the Official Regulations, the CEV U17/U18 Volleyball European Championship 2022 will only be open to:

Female players (U17) must be:

Born on 1st January 2006 or thereafter

Male players (U18) must be:

Born on 1st January 2005 or thereafter

3. Registration procedure and deadline

The registration for this edition will be done through the CEV Database using the following form:

01CH (Team Registration)

The registration deadline for closing and sending the above-mentioned form is:

Tuesday June 15, 2021 at 23:59 CET

After closing the form on-line, National Federations must click 'Print Form' and then sign and stamp the paper copy and send it by registered letter to the CEV Office.

On this form there are tick boxes to inform CEV if the respective National Federation intends to apply to organise one of the 2nd Round qualification tournaments. However, the definitive application forms and required procedure for applying to organise a tournament will be sent to all NFs after the completing the 1st Round qualification.

4. 1st Round format and dates confirmation

Following the receipt of the confirmed list of registered teams, each Zonal Association must confirm to CEV their competition structure and dates by Monday 05th July 2021 at the latest.

In principal CEV needs to have at the latest one month before the start of the planned tournament, all details about teams and match schedule in order to process the competition via CEV database (all CEV forms, license 04, 05, etc.).

5. Competition principals, format and dates

General principal based on the latest BOA decisions are that the organisers of Finals are not allowed participating in the Qualifications. **Athletes of NFs category 4 & 5 can only participate in two age-group competitions (incl. Senior) per year.**

The 2022 competition will be structured as follows:

1st Round (ZONAL)

The 1st round will be organised in each of the six CEV Zonal Associations. Following the registration, CEV will inform each about the exact number of National Federations from their respective zone who have registered for participation.

Moreover, further to a decision made by the CEV Board of Administration, a minimum of 40% of the respective National Federations have to register for participation in order for the zonal event to count as a 1st Round qualifier for the European Championship.

If one or more Zonal Associations fail to fulfil this requirement, depending on the total number of teams registered for participation in the championship, their teams might:

- have to join those from another zone to compete in the first stage of the qualification process
- join a qualifying round including teams from different zones put together as per the results of a Drawing of Lots
- move on straight to the 2nd Round organised by the CEV, with a maximum of 20 teams per gender participating in this round.

Each Zonal Association shall organise their qualification stage according to the calendar set by CEV for this round (i.e. before 31st January 2022).

In each tournament, the first placed team qualifies directly to the Final Round.

2ND Round

The 2nd round is organised with a maximum of 20 National Federations who competed in but did not qualify from the 1st round to the Final Round. If the Final Round is organized by the two National Federations and, all Zones are hosting the 1st Round tournaments, the maximum number of participated National Federation in the 2nd Round will be reduced to 16, depending if all 6 Zonal Associations will play the respective 1st Round tournaments.

The number of the granted vacancies per Zone (quotas) in the 2nd Round depends on the total number of the registered teams. The team quota per Zone to qualify to 2nd Round is based on the percentage of overall European Ranking points per Zone calculated based on participating teams.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

- The 2nd Round will be played using the single round robin tournaments format (i.e. one tournament "one against each other").
- Each 2nd Round tournament will be played with minimum three and maximum four teams.
- The teams in each 2nd Round will play one tournament over three competitions days:
 - Tournament with 3 teams: each team will play 2 competition days
 - Tournament with 4 teams: each team will play 3 competition days
- Each of the National Federations involved has the right to apply for the organisation of the tournament.
- Should more than one National Federation apply for the organisation, the organisers will be drawn by the CEV. Or should no National Federation apply for the organisation, the organiser will be drawn by the CEV.
- In each pool, the first best placed team qualifies to the Final round. In case of a vacancy in the Final round, the next best placed team across all pools qualifies to the Final round.

6. 2nd Round seeding of the teams / Drawing of Lots

Following the completion of the 1st Round, CEV will confirm the teams qualified to the 2nd round. For the 2nd round, the Drawing of Lots shall be combined with a seeding of National Federations, also considering geographical proximity. This will take place in the CEV Office in February 2022.

7. 2nd Round organisation application

Forms to apply to organise 2nd Round tournaments will be sent to all participating teams after the 31st January 2022.

8. FIVB World Championships 2023 (U18/U19)

The highest classified teams, not already qualified, from the CEV U17 Women / U18 Men Volleyball European Championship 2022 will qualify for the respective FIVB U18 Women / U19 Men Volleyball World Championships 2023 according to the vacancies granted by FIVB to Europe per gender. The vacancies are still to be announced by FIVB.

9. European Youth Olympic Festival Qualification – 2023 EYOF

The best eight or seven*) countries from the CEV U17 Women / U18 Men CEV Volleyball European Championships 2022 will be invited to participate in the 2023 European Youth Olympic Festival in Maribor (SLO).

*) The hosting nation (SLO) has the right to nominate their boys and girls team even if not among the top 8 of the U17/U18 European Championships. In case they renounce to participate with one of the national teams concerned (either boys or girls) or with both (boys and girls), the right to compete goes automatically to the next nation, on the basis of the final standing achieved in the CEV U17W/U18M European Championship 2022.

2. Teams Qualified from 1st Round to 2nd Round

Following the team registrations, we would like to confirm the registered teams per zone in the 1st Round and the vacancies quotas of the 2nd Round per zone. The five zonal winners will qualify directly to the Final Round, and each Zone will have a number in vacancies in the 2nd round as per the table below. The European Championship organiser U18M GEO and U17W CZE are not participating any qualification round.

As the SCA will not compete as one of the zones, only five zonal tournaments will be played, therefore it was decided by CEV to increase the 2nd Round teams from 16 to 20 in both competitions.

*For the avoidance of doubt, although the "Betting & gambling services" sector and/or category is reserved by the CEV, the Organiser may exploit, based on prior agreement of the CEV, the category for the "National lottery", provided that their sports betting operations are in no way presented under the same brand as their National lottery operations. Thus, gambling and betting services are prohibited and the category will not be released by the CEV.

The CEV partner is the ultimate betting rights holder on a global basis in relation to the National team and Club competitions, including the CEV Volleyball U19/20 European Championship.

5. Media rights & Digital Coverage (2nd Round)

Media Rights & Production standards

The production of matches in relation the CEV U17 Women / U18 Men Volleyball European Championship 2022 Qualifiers are optional.

In case the appointed National Federations wish to produce matches of the CEV Competition, the CEV is granting to the National Federations the non-exclusive domestic media rights in relation only to the matches organized by the National Federations in their host territory in exchange of the production of such matches in accordance with the CEV standards indicated in *Section 7: Media Production* of the CEV Volleyball Competition Regulations. There is no media rights reciprocity allowed between organizing National Federations.

The National Federations are allowed to live stream matches of the CEV Competition (i.e. the matches being produced in their territory) in their digital platforms including Facebook & YouTube pertaining a state-of-the-art geo-blocking. This means the streams should be only available within the host territory.

More particularly, the National Federations shall respect the following requirements:

- To inform the CEV Digital & TV department of their wish to produce matches minimum 2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament.
- To respect CEV production standards including number of cameras & integration of the CEV official TV graphics package (TV graphics are provided by the CEV).
- To provide CEV and relevant partners the signal of the produced matches via Internet (RTMP) or via satellite delivery (Eutelsat carrier).



7. Final Round: Competition accreditation badges

8. Final Round: Broadcasting standards & signal delivery

The Organisers shall follow the minimum below broadcasting requirements during the Final Round:

Production obligation	Semi-Finals 1-4, Bronze and Gold Medal Matches (total of 4 matches)
Number of cameras	3 HD cameras
TV graphics	Provided by the CEV via FTP protocol
TV signal delivery	Via <u>European satellite only</u> (Eutelsat 10A or 7b)*

**It is the responsibility of the Organizer to book at their own cost the SNG truck on-site and the necessary satellite segment. Satellite parameters shall be provided to the CEV no later than one week prior to the tournament.*

The Organiser shall provide to tv@cev.eu the contact details of their appointed host broadcaster or 3rd party production provider no later than 2 weeks prior to the event.

The CEV reserve the rights to live stream the matches of the Final Round on its official digital platforms.

9. Final Round: Branding

The graphics and marketing department work with the file sharing platform on cloud.

All graphics (Banner, backdrop, poster, logos etc.) shall be downloaded from the CEV Cloud.

Production of backdrop, poster, digital promotion is compulsory. Any other promotional material with CEV identification markers shall be uploaded for approval.

Please note that we do not provide any ticket and brochure / Program layouts. However, all the relevant information and logos must be included in the design layout produced by the organisers, namely CEV logo, competition title and logo. The production of an official brochure / official program is not mandatory.

All graphics are available for downloading from the CEV Cloud. All Organisers have the opportunity to review the basic Brand Guidelines, to download and use the official competition logo and graphic devices in various formats, as needed.

UPLOAD FOLDER:

for all files to be uploaded, checked and approved by CEV before producing. The upload folder is structured by National federation's/organiser's name <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/natteamsupl>

- All layouts & files (e.g. LED playlist, etc.) must be uploaded for final approval into the National federation's/organisers folder.

IMPORTANT: After uploading any files for approval, the graphics department graphics@cev.eu has to be notified by a short e-mail.

Note that, the cloud doesn't inform us automatically on the uploading of new files.

10. European Youth Olympic Festival 2023 (EYOF)

The 2023 European Youth Olympic Festival will be held in Maribor (SLO) between 23-29/07/2023.

The best 7 teams will qualify from the CEV U17/U18 European Championship 2022 to the EYOF 2023 edition together with the teams of the organising National Federation Slovenia (SLO).

The respective age limits will be confirmed by the National Olympic Committees in due time.

11. FIVB World Championships 2023 – WU19/MU19

After the decision by the FIVB Board of Administration regarding the adjustment of the FIVB Volleyball Age Group World Championships, the FIVB will align the age groups / limits between the genders as of 2023 and onwards.

This means that starting from the 2023 edition, the World Championships will be open to both Girls' Under 19 and Boys' Under 19, i.e. for athletes born on or after 1 January 2005.

The FIVB has granted six slots per gender to CEV for the 2023 edition of both the Girls' U19 and Boys' U19 World Championships. Those respective Finals will be played with 20 teams in total and will be composed of 19 teams in total from Confederations Championships plus the organiser (TBC).
